Food Ministry Team

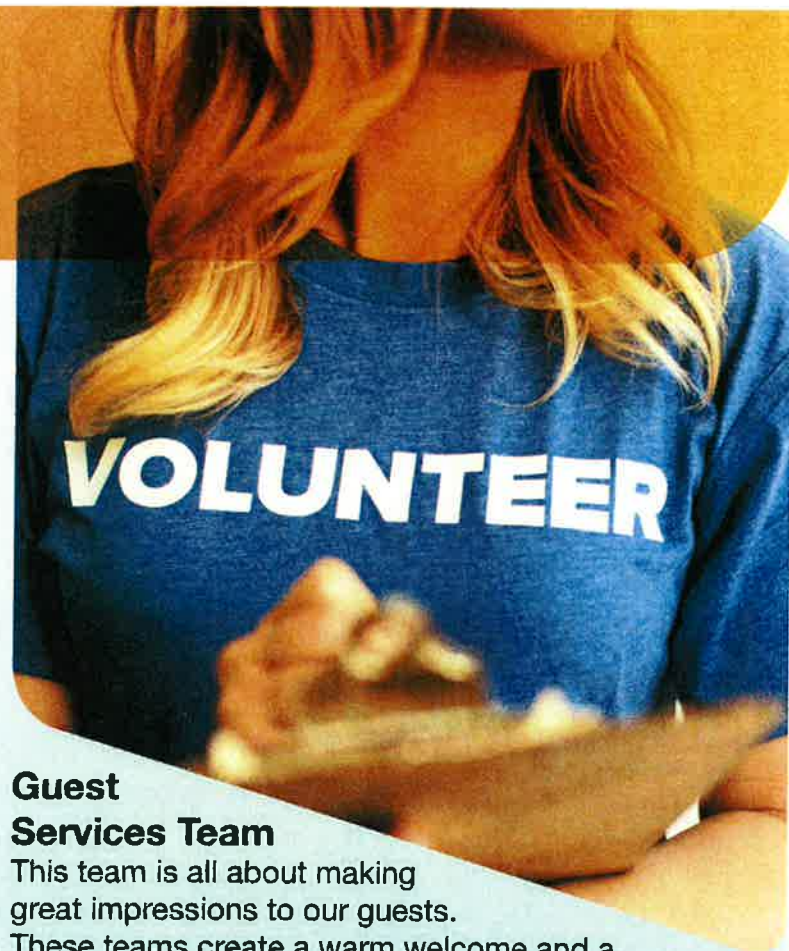
